

BONBRIGHT FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is a one-time \$500.00 award to a Sandwich High School graduate entering his or her freshman year in a two or four year college program. The student should major or minor in music, or continue to pursue a passion for music in college.

Dr. James C. Bonbright (1891-1985) was a professor of finance at Columbia University from 1919-1960, and a former trustee and chairman of the New York State Power Agency. He wrote several books, and was considered an expert in the area of valuation of property and public utility regulation. He had three children, and several grandchildren, in all of whom he instilled his love of music.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarship applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

1. Must be a Senior at Sandwich High School;
2. Must major or minor in music OR continue the pursuit of music performance opportunities in college OR enroll in music classes
3. Must submit grade point average/SAT scores;
4. Demonstrate leadership and community service;
5. Must have participated in some form of music education either in the Sandwich Public Schools or an outside facility.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Completed Scholarship Application form
2. High School transcript with GPA
3. SAT scores
4. One letter of recommendation from a music instructor either in the Sandwich Public Schools or any other formal music instruction facility
5. An essay of 300 words or less on how music has been a meaningful aspect of your life.

DEADLINES

Applications Accepted: February 1 – March 15
Committee review of application: Early April
Selection of Scholarship recipient: Early May
